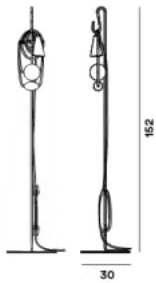

ANDREA ANASTASIO

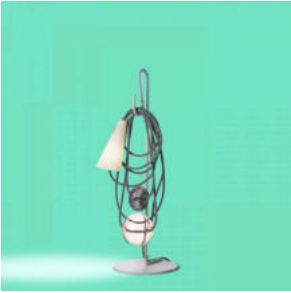

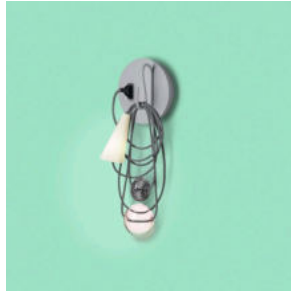
